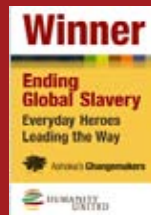

Who We Sponsor for School:

The Emancipation Network sponsors 100 child survivors and kids born into brothels to attend school, many for the first time in their lives. Some of these children have been enslaved in brothels for sexual exploitation, before being rescued and sent to aftercare shelters. Others were enslaved for industrial work or as domestic servants.

How Sponsorship Helps: Children who are enslaved, or whose parents are in slavery, are destined to grow up and repeat the cycle *unless* they are given education and ongoing support to build a different kind of life. Education transforms not only the individual children, but also their families and communities, serving as an inspiring example to others, and ultimately bringing sustainable income into the family and community.

Sponsorship Pays For:

School fees, uniforms and supplies, transportation, and either room and board in shelters or boarding schools, or before and after-school support and tutoring services for children living with their families.

What We Don't Do:

Unlike many other school sponsorship programs, who use as much as 50% of sponsorship donations for administrative fees, The Emancipation Network uses 100% of sponsorship fees for the children's education. Our overhead costs are covered by the sale of products MadeBySurvivors and by a foundation grant

What we offer Sponsors: Quarterly updates, cards from sponsored children, and report cards twice yearly.

The Problem:

Modern Day Slavery is an international human rights crisis. According to the UN, there are 27 million in the world today. Human beings are bought and sold on an international market for astonishingly small amounts of money, and then used for sexual exploitation, domestic work, industrial labor - such as brickmaking, quarries, or carpet looming, agriculture work, or as child soldiers or beggars.

Once in slavery, victims' very lives are at risk - many child slaves do not survive to adulthood. Slavery exists in every country of the world, including the United States. Regions particularly hard hit by slavery include South and Southeast Asia, Sub-Saharan Africa and the former Soviet Republics.

The majority of the world's slaves are women and children. UNICEF estimates that at least 100,000 new children are trafficked each year into the sex industry alone.

Thankfully, many children are rescued from slavery in raids and interventions by international and local agencies. However, survivors of slavery still face extreme challenges - in many cases, they are so stigmatized, they can never return home, or it may not be safe to do so.

Living in slavery, they have been deprived of education, and most are traumatized from years of severe abuse and torture. Thus, reintegrating into mainstream society is nearly impossible without intensive support.

This is where The Emancipation Network school sponsorship comes into the picture.

School Sponsorship Programs & Partners

- **Apple of God's Eye, Kathmandu, Nepal:** TEN sponsors 28 Apne Aap children to attend private day schools, or Boarding schools if living at home is not a safe option for them. Apne Aap provides services to women and children in red light areas, where they witness and experience violence and discrimination.

- **Apple of God's Eye, Kathmandu, Nepal:** provides an exceptionally loving and nurturing environment for survivors of slavery and street children. The staff opened the doors of their very own school on April 27, 2009. Ten of these beautiful children are sponsored for school by TEN.

- **Princess Project, Thamel, Kathmandu, Nepal:** Pastor Ranjit and his wife Sarah created a shelter in their church for homeless children and survivors of slavery in the tourist district of Kathmandu. The girls live at "The Princess Home" and ten of them will begin their education this Spring. We are very excited to partner with Pastor Ranjit and Sarah in providing this opportunity.

- **Chaunduli Freedom School, Northern India:** TEN's Freedom School in Uttar Pradesh, India, educates 50 boys and girls who were recently weilding the tools of heavy labor rather than pencils, working in quarries or toiling on farms from dawn to dusk, and the future seemed devoid of other alternatives. The school also serves as an outreach center to help the entire community escape from slavery

- **Women's Interlink Foundation** provides services to child survivors of slavery and red light children in West Bengal through rescue, shelter care, opportunity and lots of love. We sponsor 15 girls at WIF, and recently refurbished their dorm room at the shelter, working with them to paint a beautiful mural.

Training Sponsorships for Young Adult Survivors

The Destiny Center in Calcutta, India is TEN's newest initiative to help young adult survivors become fully independent. Rescued survivors who have received several years of aftercare, education, and training at our partner shelters, now receive fairly paid and dignified work, along with training, counseling and reintegration services, allowing them to support themselves for the first time in their lives.

One of the biggest problems confronting shelters is that the survivors have no place to go. They are often not welcome back in their own communities, especially if they were sold into prostitution. Typically they were trafficked at a young age (average 11-12 years) and have never lived independently. This not only limits the options for the survivors but it also means the shelters can't free up space to take in newly rescued girls.
